The regular monthly meeting of the City of McCaysville Mayor & Council was held on **Tuesday, April 10, 2018** with Mayor Thomas Seabolt presiding.

On a motion by Councilman Patterson and a second by Councilman Wagner, the March minutes were approved as read.

On a motion by Councilman Patterson and a second by Councilwoman Beaver, the April bills were approved for payment.

Councilman Wagner presented the Council with a proposal from ServLine for leak insurance for review and discussion at the next regular meeting.

Mayor Seabolt opened a public hearing on three malt beverage and wine license applications from Susan Griffin (Burra Burra Seafood Company, Cowanee Restaurant, Inc., and Concetta's Riverside Bakery & Café, Inc.). After soliciting comments, Councilman Wagner made a motion to approve the applications. Motion seconded by Councilman Patterson and carried. Councilman Quintrell abstained.

Mayor Seabolt opened a public hearing on one malt beverage license application from Joseph Ray (Joe's BBQ). After soliciting comments, Councilman Wagner made a motion to approve the application. Councilman Patterson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Councilman Quintrell abstained.

Councilman Patterson made a motion to close the regular meeting and go into executive session to consult and meet with legal counsel pertaining to pending or potential litigation. Motion to close the meeting was seconded by Councilman Wagner; Councilwoman Beaver-Aye, Councilman Collis-Aye, Councilman Quintrell-Aye.

On a motion by Councilman Patterson and a second by Councilman Wagner, the Regular meeting was reconvened, all ayes.

Chief Earley gave his monthly report. Earley also stated that he had ^{been} advised that a mesh fence will be put up in the construction area downtown. Chief Earley stated that his patrolmen were going to start a regular check of businesses at night and would be leaving a card to let the business

owners know.

Chris Abbott asked about the contract the City signed last fall to start on the City Park.


Tara Akins asked about the lights that were removed from the bridge and said she was interested in getting one.
